The BID Documents are hereby amended as follows:

A. RESPONSES TO SUBMITTED QUESTIONS:

Question 1

Regarding RFP 19-02 Disaster Debris Removal and Disposal Services, are tipping fees to be considered a passthrough to the City, or do we need to add disposal fees to our price proposal?

- **Response to Question 1**

Tipping fees will be considered a pass-through to the Town provided that the loads are prepared in accordance with all local, state, and federal laws; and provided that the Contractor completes the appropriate forms, and completes them fully and accurately.

Question 2

Hi, I'm Rodney. I work for a tree trimming company and seeing this project you guys have for the debris pick up and wanted to ask a few questions about it.

Question 4

I have read the Town's RFP for Disaster Removal & Disposal and have the following questions:

1. Will the Town consider changing the unit of measure for the following line items:
 - a. Line Item 6 – hazardous materials - from \$/CY to \$/Pound
 - b. Line Item 7 – dead animals - from \$/CY to \$/Pound
 - c. Line Item 8 – hazardous trees - from \$/CY to \$/each
 - d. Line Item 9 – stumps - from \$/CY to \$/each
2. How will the Hourly Fee schedule be used in the evaluation of the bid in terms of price? Will the hourly rates be given the same weight as the unit rates? Will you add all hourly rates up to get a lump sum number to compare against other proposals? Will the Town add up all unit rate line items for a lump sum to compare each proposer for lowest bid?

These items are listed only as a “placeholder.” However, the “Hourly Fee Schedule” is required to be filled out for the listed personnel and equipment. If during the course of the work a forced account is utilized the incurred costs will be paid by the Town, provided sufficient backup documentation is provided.

2. Tab 2 has a bulleted listing of things that need to be included in the proposal

3. Do you have a disposal agreement with WM or any other landfill?
4. Do you already have DMS’s located and permitted?

- Answer to Question 5

- 1a Contractors shall demonstrate ability to manage work described under the Statement of Work in Section III (Debris Removal, Debris Processing, Documentation and Records, and Work Requirements) while performing the tasks under each event type for potential scenarios as described in Section II, Scope Work.
- 2a Attachments for Tab 2 can be placed within other Tabs when appropriate to avoid multiple duplications of attachments.
- 3a YES, the Town currently has a disposal agreement with WM. However, the Town could have an agreement in place with a different company at the time this contract becomes effective.
- 4a YES, the Town uses Broward County DMS, if opened.

Question 6

Please confirm is a bid bond is required at time of bid submission and if so, what percent or amount?

- Answer to Question 6
The bid bond is set at 5% of the total Value. Since the Value is undetermined, the Town will use an estimated Value of \$400,000 of which \$20,000 will be set as the bid bond.
