

RESOLUTION NO. 2020- 007

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE PARK, FLORIDA, REALLOCATING AND REAPPROPRIATING MONIES FOR EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 – 2019; PROVIDING FOR ALL OTHER ITEMS IN THE BUDGET OF EXPENSES TO REMAIN UNCHANGED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; SUPERSEDING CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2018, the Pembroke Park Town Commission adopted Resolution 18-09-11 approving the annual budget appropriating and allocating monies for the payment of municipal expenditures for the operation of the Town of Pembroke Park for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2018 and ending September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, due to unanticipated municipal activities it has become necessary to reallocate and reappropriate certain budgeted expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE PARK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the appropriations for expenditures in the Fiscal Year 2019 – 2020 annual budget are hereby reallocated and reappropriated for the payment of expenditures incident to the operation of the Town of Pembroke Park in all government functions and capacities, as the same are designated, adjusted, and set forth in the reallocation of funds for the Fiscal Year 2018 – 2019, attached hereto as Exhibit A, and made a part hereof by reference.

Section 2: That all others provisions of Resolution 18-09-11 and the Fiscal Year 2018 – 2019 budget of expenses which are not in conflict with this or any other part of this Resolution shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Section 3: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is

held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

Section 4: That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
