

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-010

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE PARK, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE EXTENSION OF THE CONSULTANT AGREEMENTS FOR THE CAPITAL HILLS CONSULTANTS, INC., CAS GOVERNMENTAL SERVICES, LLC, AND HELMICH CONSULTING, INC. THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2020; AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND APPROPRIATE TOWN OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER SUCH DOCUMENTS AS NECESSARY TO EXTEND THE CONSULTANT AGREEMENTS AS PROVIDED FOR HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; SUPERSEDING CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Commission has previously entered into agreements with The Capital Hills Consultants, Inc., CAS Governmental Services, LLC, and Helmich Consulting, Inc., to provide professional services regarding matters that may come before the Florida Legislature in the 2020 Florida Legislative Session and other related governmental entities; and

WHEREAS, the respective agreements for professional services are due to expire; and

WHEREAS, the Town Commission desires to extend the professional services agreements with the legislative consultants through the end of the Fiscal Year 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE PARK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the Town Commission hereby agrees to extend the term of the professional services agreements with The Capital Hills Consultants, Inc., CAS Governmental Services, LLC, and Helmich Consulting, Inc., through September 30, 2020.

Section 2: That the Mayor and appropriate Town officials are authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all documents necessary in order to extend the term of the

professional services agreements for The Capital Hills Consultants, Inc., CAS Governmental Services, LLC, and Helmich Consulting, Inc., through September 30, 2020.

Section 3: That the Town Manager is directed to execute the lobbyist registration office forms to allow The Capital Hills Consultants, Inc., CAS Governmental Services, LLC, and Helmich Consulting, Inc. to represent the Town during the 2020 Florida Legislative Session.

Section 4 That if any clause, section, other part or application of this Resolution is held by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications of this Resolution.

Section 5 That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict.

Section 6 That this Resolution shall be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
