NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all parties that the Town Commission of the Town of Pembroke Park, Broward County, Florida, is conducting a Public Hearing in the Town Commission Chambers of Town Hall, located at 3150 S.W. 52nd Avenue, Pembroke Park, Florida, on Wednesday, April 8, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as may be heard, on the following ordinances, to-wit:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE PARK, FLORIDA, RELATING TO CHAPTER 12, HEALTH AND SANITATION, CREATING A NEW SECTION ENTITLED IMMINENT PUBLIC HEALTH THREAT; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; SUPERSEDING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE PARK, FLORIDA RELATING TO CHAPTER 3, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; AMENDING SECTION 3-2.5, EXTENDED HOURS LICENSE; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; SUPERSEDING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

and place of this hearing and govern yourself accordingly. The Public Hearing may be continued to a time and date certain by announcement at the scheduled Public Hearing without any further published notice.

Any person who decides to appeal any decision of the Town Commission with respect to any matter considered at this meeting will need a record of the proceedings and, for such purpose, may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
